No lifeguards are present. Swim at your own risk

Stockholders and Associate Members who have paid their current year's service fees are welcome to enjoy all the facilities.

For security and safety reasons the use of or access to the CBHC beach, is restricted to Stockholders and Associate Members. Keys or codes issued to members are for personal use only and are not to be duplicated, loaned, or used to facilitate unauthorized access to CBHC facilities. Gates are to be closed and locked after each use.

Stockholders and associate Members are not allowed to bring a non-member who resides within the confines of Cape Breton to the beach. That includes an adult or child

No one under the age of 14 is permitted on the beach unless accompanied by an adult 18 years or older

Beach badges must be worn on the beach at all times. Children over the age of 7 must wear a badge

Absolutely no glass is allowed on the beach

No pets allowed on the beach and dock. When accessing your boat, dogs must be carried or walked on the shortest practical leash and must take the most direct route to and from your boat- no free run. The owner must control their animal at all times

Children on floatation devices must stay in the shallow areas unless accompanied by an adult

No feeding wildlife on the beach

Please dispose all trash and recyclables in proper receptacles

No fireworks on the beach

Gates are to remain closed and locked at all times
