Stockholder's Meeting

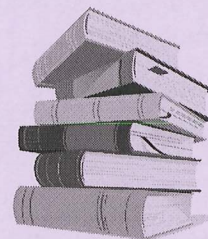
The next meeting of the stockholders will be on Sunday, April 7th at 11:00 AM at the clubhouse.
