## President's Letter

Last year the lead story was the renovation of the clubhouse. We had hoped that everyone would be able to enjoy the refurbished space, but it seems the COVID-19 virus had a different idea. At the August meeting stockholders voted to change the bylaws and move the first meeting from the Sunday after Memorial Day to the last Sunday in March. The early meeting is to approve the budget, which is included in this newsletter. Unfortunately, like last year, we will not be able to meet to approve the budget. As a result, we will repeat the method we used last year to approve the budget by proxy.

This year's entertainment schedule will depend on the state guidelines for crowd size in both indoor and outdoor gatherings. After having a portion of the electrical system repaired an unusually high tide caused the failure of a second section of the electrical system. This section provides power to some of the ice eaters, so we have been lucky. This major repair needs to be addressed and stockholders have approved the expenditure.

There are changes coming to the beach which include a new entrance gate at the end of Bretonian Dr. Other topics will be discussed by our new beach chair Larry Sramowicz in his article. We hope to see even more of our members soaking up the sun.

Our web page has a new look. We hope you enjoy the new look and ease of navigating the site. We plan on adding features to make it more responsive to our membership. Feel free to make suggestions to improve what is being offered. Cape Breton also has a presence on Facebook with a group and page.

## Stockholder's Meeting

At our August meeting you voted to change the bylaws to move the first meeting of the year to the last Sunday of March unless it is a holiday. Unfortunately, the first year since the change was enacted, the meeting date is on Palm Sunday. With the following Sunday being Easter, the meeting is now scheduled for April 11th. However, since COVID-19 protocols do not allow us to meet, we will be asking you to use your proxy to pass this years budget.

# Beach Committee

Here we are at 2021, a New Year. 2020 was a setback for Cape Breton. There were no events held on the beach last year due to the virus. Hopefully 2021 will be more promising.

Cape Breton has one of the nicest beaches on the River. The beach committee will continue to make new improvements to our beach, to be the best on the Metedeconk River.

There were a number of projects facilitated last Fall. A step was added to the bottom of the staircase leading to the dock, a new dawn to dusk light was installed on top of a 4x4 post next to stairs, a retaining wall was installed for garbage cans next to the stairs, repairs were made to the electrical shed, Crabby Shack received a fresh coat of paint, and a new retaining wall was installed at the east end of beach by the shower.

There will be a new single gate, with a push button code lock, installed at the east end of the beach next to double gate. We will have beach sand delivered and spread over the existing sand. The water will be tested weekly with the results posted on the bulletin board.

We had abundant amount of seaweed wash up on our beach last year. The landscaper spent too much time picking it up and wasn't able focus his attentions on the beach. We will be taking on that responsibility this year and need volunteers to help us with this endeavor. Even if you can only help infrequently, your assistance would be greatly appreciated.

The beach season runs from Memorial Day to Labor Day, please keep a safe distance and wear a mask, as needed due to the virus.

Many thanks to the Garden Club for their hard work on the beach. It looks so vibrant from all the flowers they planted. And, thanks to Cathy and Larry Peter for their Fall leaf cleanup. Great job.


# Clubhouse
