

Beach Rules

(revised March 2026)

- ❖ No lifeguards are present. Swim at your own risk.
- ❖ Stockholders in Good Standing and Associate Members who have paid their current year's service fees are welcome to enjoy the beach.
- ❖ For security and safety reasons the use of or access to the Cape Breton Holding Co., Inc. beach, is restricted to Stockholders in Good Standing and Associate Members. Keys or codes issued to Stockholders in Good Standing and Associate Members are for personal use only and are not to be duplicated, loaned, shared or used to facilitate unauthorized access to the Cape Breton Holding Co., Inc. beach.
- ❖ Stockholders in Good Standing and Associate Members are not allowed to bring non-members who reside within the confines of Cape Breton to the beach or dock. That includes an adult or child.
- ❖ **Beach badges must be worn on the beach at all times.** Children over the age of 7 must wear a badge at all times.
- ❖ No one under the age of 14 is permitted on the beach unless accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at all times.
- ❖ Absolutely no glass is allowed on the beach or dock.
- ❖ No pets allowed on the beach or dock. When accessing your boat, dogs must be carried or walked on the shortest practical leash and must take the most direct route to and from your boat- no free run. The owner must control their animal at all times
- ❖ Children on floatation devices must stay in the shallow areas unless accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at all times
- ❖ Please dispose of all trash and recyclables in proper trash and recyclable receptacles provided on the beach and outside the beach.
- ❖ No Fireworks on the beach
- ❖ No feeding wildlife on the beach
- ❖ No personal property may be left on the beach or dock overnight
- ❖ Gates are to remain closed and locked at all times
